<b>1</b>	Complete the entire section. Indicate transaction type. Include the Vermont registration number, if one exists. If previously registered in another jurisdiction, enter the registration number where indicated (Include a two-letter abbreviation of state/province). Homemade vessels require <a href="#">Statement of Origin (VD-027)</a> and <a href="#">Assignment of HIN # (VT-003)</a> . All motorboats manufactured on or after 11/01/1972 must have a 12 to 17-digit Hull Identification Number.
<b>2</b>	Complete owner/co-owner information section. Enter the physical address if the mailing address is a PO Box. I
<b>3</b>	You must indicate your choice for rights of survivorship if more than one owner is listed.
<b>4</b>	Complete if you have a loan on this vessel. If there is a second lien holder, send details and an additional lien holder fee.
<b>5</b>	The name and address of the seller and the date purchased are required for new and transfer applications, even if the motorboat has been registered and titled to you out-of-state. The seller's signature is only required if not on the Certificate of Origin/Title or Bill of Sale.
<b>6</b>	To be completed by dealers only.
<b>7</b>	The first registration of a motorboat/personal watercraft in Vermont will be subject to the sales tax unless: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A purchase invoice shows a sales tax of 6% or more paid to a dealer in any of the 45 state jurisdictions imposing a sales tax (Alaska, Montana, Delaware, New Hampshire, and Oregon do not have Sales and Use tax).</li> <li>• The applicant is a nonresident of Vermont and purchased the vessel in a state other than Vermont.</li> <li>• The applicant is a nonresident of Vermont and purchased the vessel in Vermont; however, they received title or possession or both in another state.</li> <li>• The applicant is a nonresident of Vermont and submits a copy of a valid registration from his home state.</li> <li>• The motorboat is acquired through a transfer to an individual, relative or not, for no payment.</li> </ul> The Tax Department must approve any claim of exemption from sales tax other than that outlined above; call 802.828.2551.
<b>9</b>	Application must be signed and dated by owner(s). If signed by an authorized agent, proof of authorization, such as power of attorney, etc. must be submitted. Owner signature certifies liability insurance is in effect for this vehicle pursuant to 23 V.S.A. §202, §203 & §3829.

#### MOTORBOAT REGISTRATION NUMBER

The Motor Vehicle Department will assign the motorboat registration number unless a title-only application. The owner shall either paint the number on each side of the bow (front section) of the motorboat or purchase the numbers and attach them to each side of the bow. The registration numbers must be positioned and of a size so that they are clearly visible.
