In concert with other State jurisdictions, the Vermont Department of Motor Vehicles now evaluates all out-of-state transactions based on your home state's laws, regulations, and policies. This form Does Not Apply to Owners of the subject vehicle who have established a legitimate connection to the State of Vermont. A legitimate connection to VT is made when a person who possesses an out-of-state Driver's License, either leases or owns a residence or physical business location in VT, is a student at a Vermont Post Secondary Educational Institution (College, University, Trade, or Vocational School), or is a contractual employee at a Vermont Business Entity.

Owners without legitimate connection to VT must complete this form before DMV processes your transaction(s). Effective immediately, unless an exception exists in your home state, DMV cannot accept this form or a registration application (ATV, Boat & Snowmobile excluded) from vehicle owners who reside in the following states: AL AK, AZ, AR, CA, CO, CT, DC, DE, FL, GA, HI, ID, IL, IN, IA, KS, KY, LA, ME, MD, MA, MI, MN, MS, MO, MT, NE, NV, NH, NJ, NM, NY, NC, ND, OH, OK, OR, PA, RI, SC, SD, TN, TX, UT, VA, WA, WV, WI, WY. This change is necessary because your home state requires its residents to register by law under civil or criminal penalties.

Please have this form completed by a Supervisor at the DMV or comparable State Motor Vehicle Administrative Organization in your home state, certifying that your home state's laws do not require that you register the vehicle there. One form is required for each vehicle.
